 - Scandic Ishavshotel
 - Malangen Brygger Resort or Camp North
- Stay central - the Radisson Blu is especially great for proximity to town and it's also a primary pick up spot for most tours.

If you're looking for a higher end, unique stay, check out Malangen Brygger Resort or Camp North. However, note that both are located much further from the city.
